Since then, she has fought mightily enduring five surgeries within three weeks of being born and has had to overcome a lung condition. Roney is the niece of JHE employee Natalie Epperly who said, "Abbey is a fighter. She has come through each of these surgeries with resilience and spunk and is showing her own personality."

Nearly a year ago, Barb Huffman, a former JHE employee, received the worst possible news a mother could hear. Her son had tragically passed away while attending school at Appalachian State University. To honor his spirit of caring and love for others, the Grayson C. Huffman Memorial Scholarship Fund was established to provide academic financial support to aspiring young athletes and automotive excellence enthusiasts.

For more than eight years, David Short has been JHE's go-to resource as a part-time truck driver. Now, Short is battling the final stages of cancer. Eddie White, a friend and JHE colleague said, "He is a good friend to a lot of people at JHE. He's a great person to work with, hardworking and would give the shirt off his back to help."

Funds from the 2015 Golfing 4 Good tournament will be divided among each beneficiary to help alleviate some of the financial burdens.
