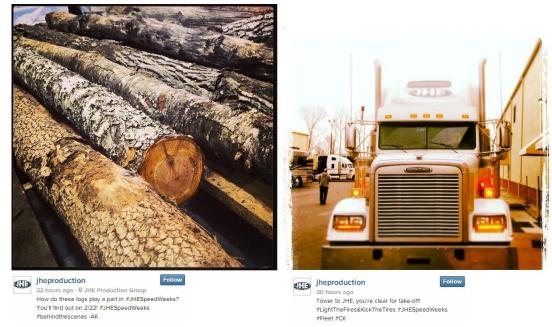




The employee who generates the most total likes during the two weeks, Feb. 10-24, will win bragging rights around the office and in the company's newsletter.
